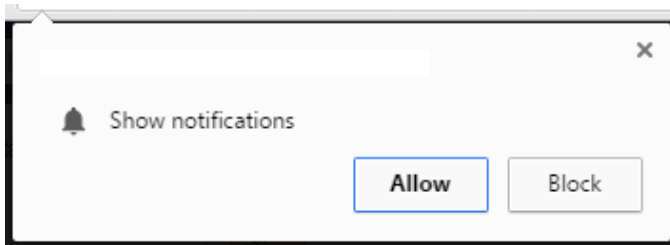


ALLOW DESKTOP NOTIFICATIONS FOR POPULAR BROWSER

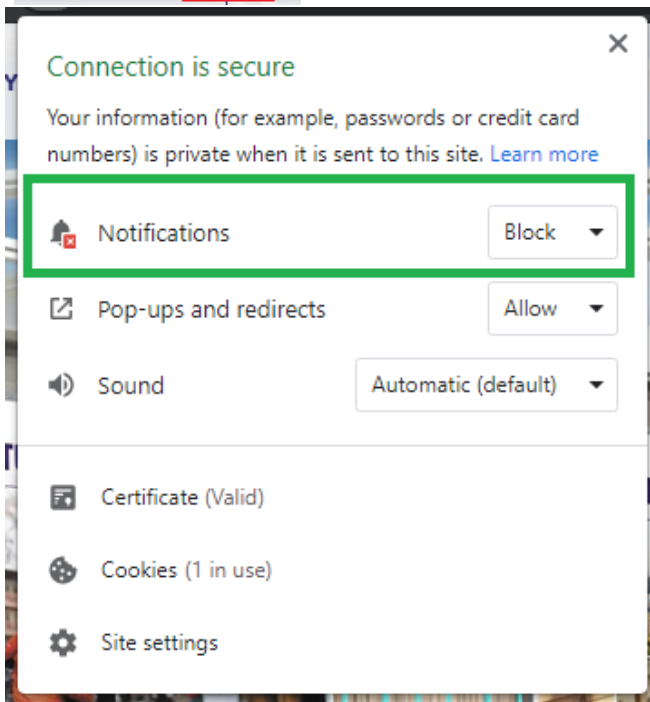


- In order to allow desktop notifications, the user should allow when prompted with the question "Show notifications" (in general, this prompt is displayed after logging in)



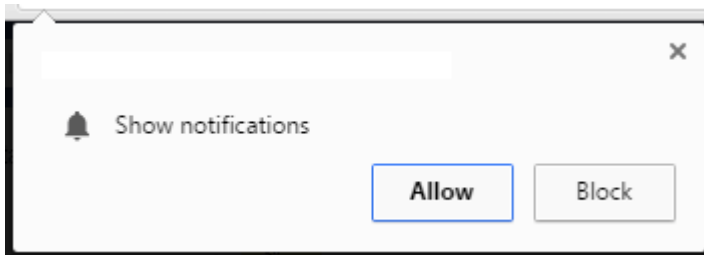

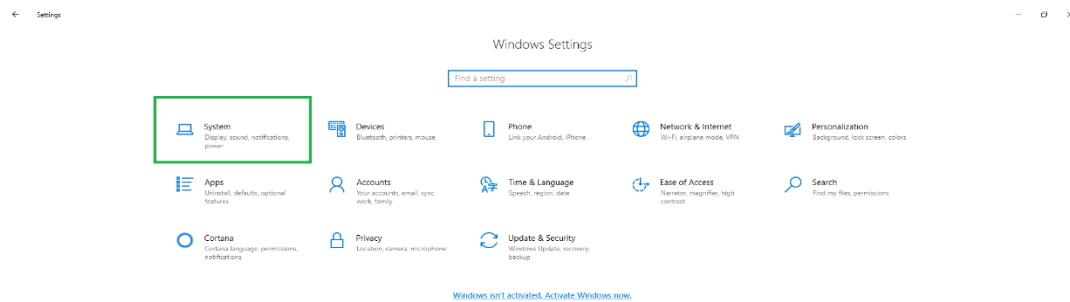


IMPORTANT!



If after performing the above steps the user still doesn't receive desktop notifications there is one more Windows setting needed:

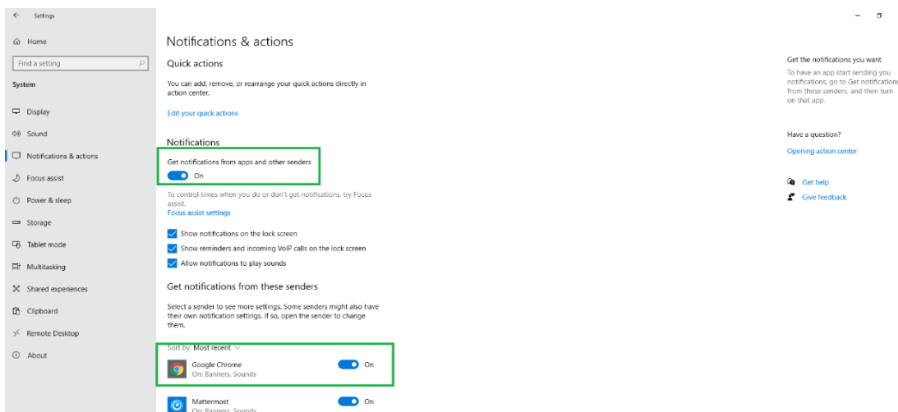
- Open the Windows settings and go to the "System" option



- Choose "Notifications & actions"



- Make sure that the "Get notifications from apps and other senders" toggle is set to ON and that the desired browser has the notifications turned on and is displayed in the "Get notifications from these senders" list



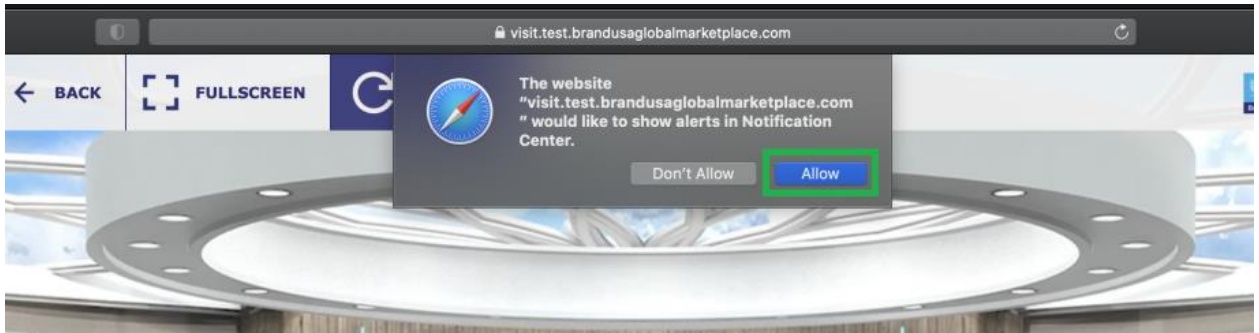

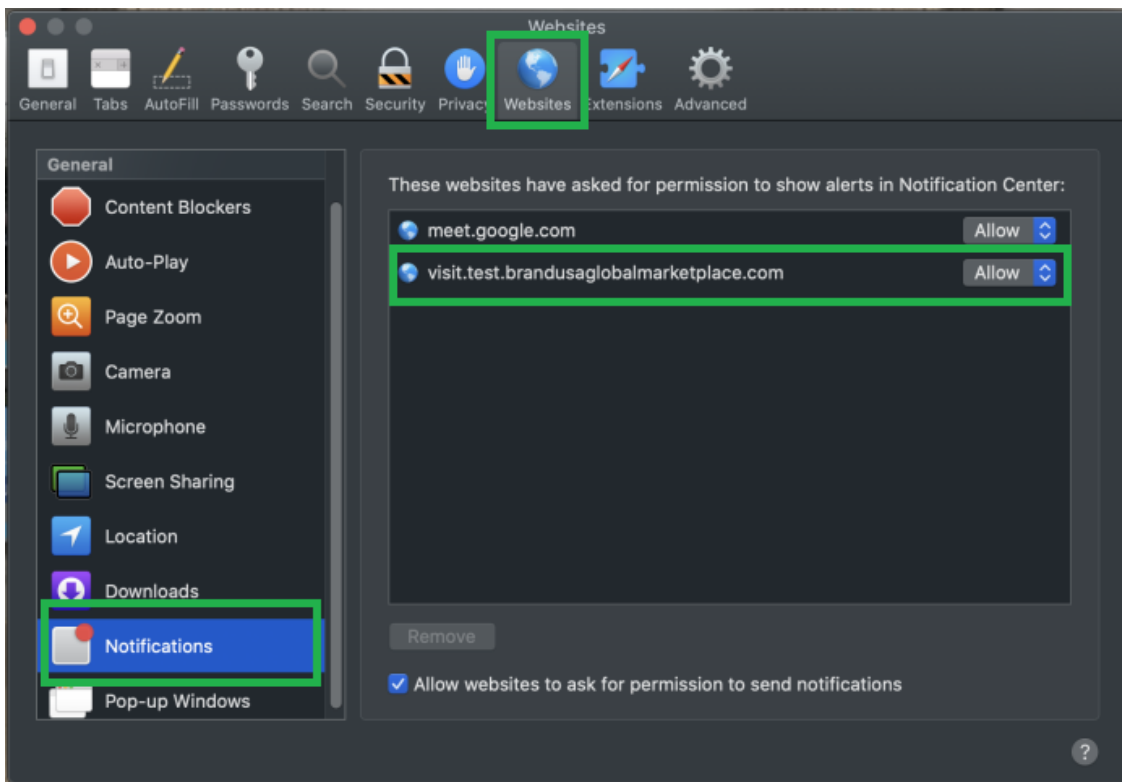

- In order to allow desktop notifications, the user should allow when prompted with the question "Show notifications" (in general, this prompt is displayed after logging in)

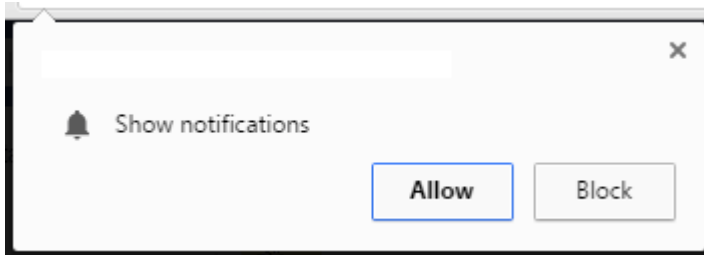


- If the user was not prompted with the pop-up or if he has accidentally not allowed it, he must go to the following menu location Safari -> Preferences... -> Websites (tab) -> Notifications (General List) and change the dropdown option from Deny to Allow



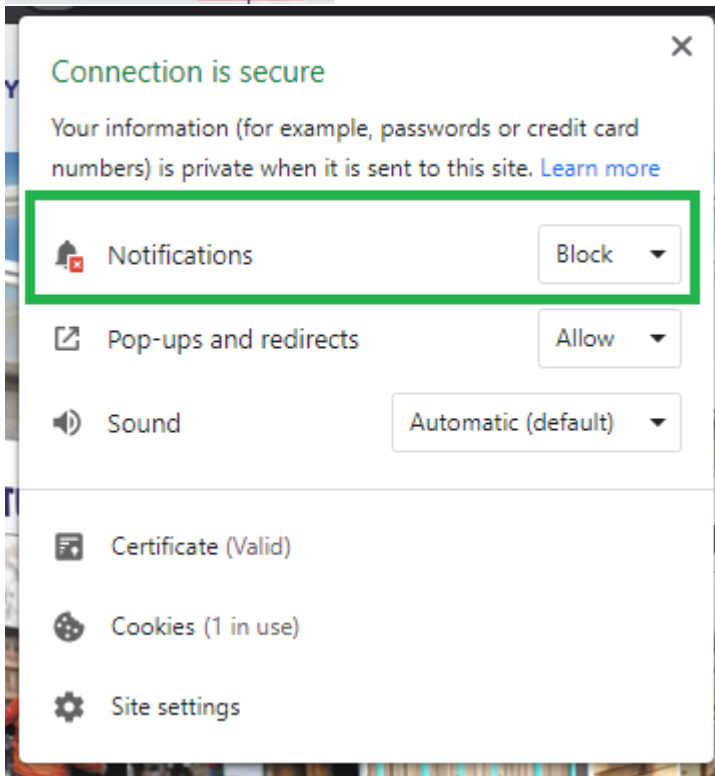

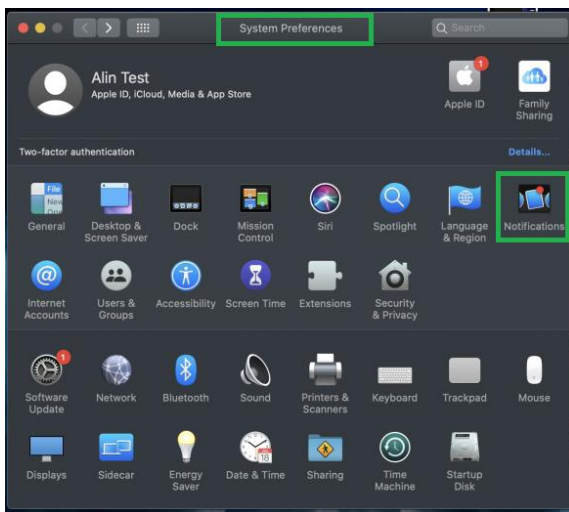

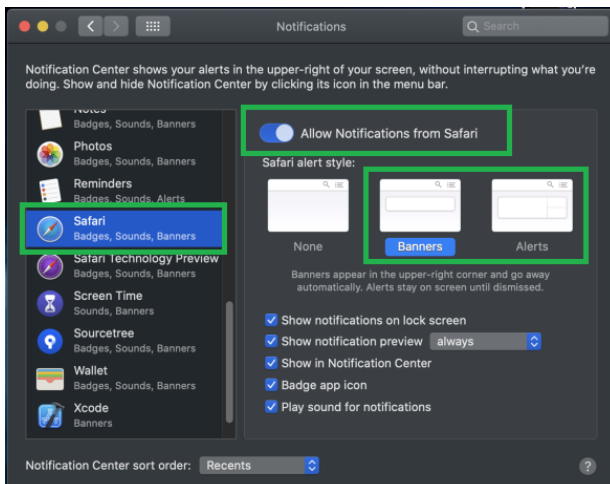

- Make sure that the "Allow Notifications from Browser Name" toggle is set to ON and that the Banners or the Alerts alert style is selected
